

FIRST NIGHT® RALEIGH 2017 CALL FOR NOVELTY ITEM VENDORS

On Saturday, December 31, 2016, downtown Raleigh will come alive as over 50,000 people celebrate the New Year as part of the 26th annual First Night Raleigh celebration. Activities will begin with the DIY Celebration from 2:00 – 6:00 PM along Bicentennial Plaza and at the North Carolina Museums of History and Natural Sciences, north of the State Capitol. The Ferris wheel and pirate ride will open at 2:00 PM on Fayetteville Street. At 6:00, the People's Procession leads thousands around the Capitol and down Salisbury and Fayetteville Streets to the Main Stage located on City Plaza for the Early Countdown, Acorn Drop, and Fireworks show at 7:00. Evening performances (from 7:00 to Midnight) will take place in nearly 30 downtown venues including the state museums, various churches and buildings surrounding the Capitol, along Fayetteville Street, and at the Duke Energy Center for the Performing Arts. The Main Stage Countdown to Midnight music will begin at 9:30 PM leading up to 2017! Festivities conclude at Midnight with the Raleigh Acorn Drop and Fireworks!



What we are looking for:

Inexpensive items to enrich audience members' experiences at the festival (eg: glow sticks, hats, noisemakers, light-ups, New Year's themed items, etc.) or novelty services (eg: caricature artists, etc.).

We do not allow:

T-Shirts, sweatshirts, CDs, food items, or any items not suitable for a family-friendly event. Artsplosure reserves the right to forbid sale of any item it deems inappropriate. Please Note: Anything resembling a gun, air horns, vuvuzelas, and similar horns are NOT permitted. Vending these items will result in immediate removal from festival, and vendor's booth fee and deposit will not be refunded.

If you are interested in participating in this year's event, **please complete the application form found on the next page and return it along with a photo of your setup and a \$50 refundable deposit by 5:00 PM on Monday, October 31, 2016.** Artsplosure reserves the right to reject any applications received after the 5:00 PM deadline. This application is not an agreement of acceptance to participate. All applicants will be notified via email no later than **Friday, November 11**, regarding their application status to First Night Raleigh 2017.

Artsplosure will email contracts to all accepted vendors. The \$50 refundable deposit will be cashed at the time of acceptance. The deposit fee will be refunded to you following the festival, provided all festival rules are adhered to. If your application is not accepted, Artsplosure will return your deposit, unless you request to be placed on a waiting list. If all contracts are not received by the contract deadline, waitlisted applicants will be offered open spaces as they become available. *Please note: In accordance with City of Raleigh regulations, ONLY vendors contracted through Artsplosure will be allowed to set up and/or vend within the First Night Raleigh festival footprint.*

BOOTH FEES:

Fayetteville Novelty Vendors Booth Fee (Maximum space: 10 x 15): **\$400**
Bicentennial Plaza Novelty Vendors Booth Fee (Maximum space: 10 x 15): **\$250**

Locations:

Spaces will be assigned along Bicentennial Plaza and along Fayetteville Street between the State Capitol and City Plaza. Bicentennial vendors will vend until 6pm or until the DIY Celebration festivities are over. All locations will be stationary booth spaces. Booths must be no larger than 10x15. Roaming vendors are NOT allowed. You may request to be considered for a certain booth space, but booth assignments will be made at the Artsplosure vendor coordinator's sole discretion based upon the needs of the festival.

Please ensure that your application is filled out completely, legibly, and accurately, and that a PHOTOGRAPH OF YOUR BOOTH IS ENCLOSED.

Upon acceptance, please be aware of the following:

- **Your full booth fee will be due with your signed contract by 5:00 PM on Friday, December 2, 2016.** *If an accepted vendor fails to return their contract and full payment by the deadline, their deposit will not be refunded. They may also be replaced with an alternate vendor at Artsposure's discretion.*
- **NO direct electricity will be provided. Only quiet generators are welcome. Please specify the type of generator you'll be using on the application.**

IMPORTANT DATES

Monday, October 31, 2016: Applications DUE! be completely and legibly filled out. Must include photos of your set up and a \$50 application deposit. You may mail or email applications.

Friday, November 11, 2016: You will be notified via email of your acceptance or application status. Contracts, maps, and information sheets will follow via email shortly after.

Friday, December 2, 2016: Booth fees and signed contracts are due by 5 PM NO EXCEPTIONS.
